**BY-LAW NO. 6/2000**

**EMERGENCY PLAN BY-LAW**

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEST ST. PAUL TO ADOPT THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANITOBA EMERGENCY MEASURES ACT AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEST ST. PAUL EMERGENCY PLAN.**

**WHEREAS** in accordance with Section 232 (1) (a) of The Municipal Act, being Chapter M225 of the Statutes of Manitoba, the council may pass by-laws for the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with Section 8 of The Emergency Measures Act, being Chapter E80 of the Statues of Manitoba, the council shall prepare, approve and adopt emergency preparedness plans;

**AND WHEREAS** the council of the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul has agreed to the necessity for a prompt and coordinated response to emergencies;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to adopt an emergency preparedness plan and to jointly enter into an agreement with the South Interlake Mutual Aid District to provide a prompt and coordinated response to emergencies;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Rural Municipality of West St. Paul, in Council assembled hereby enact as follows:

1. **THAT** this By-law may be referred to as the "Emergency Plan By-law".
2. **THAT** the attached Schedule "A" hereafter known as the RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WEST ST PAUL EMERGENCY PLAN is hereby approved and adopted.
3. **THAT** the Council and Reeve of the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul may implement the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul Emergency Plan in accordance with the procedures agreed to and set forth in the Plan.
4. **THAT** the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul may enter into mutual aid agreements for emergency response.
5. **THAT** the Emergency Coordinator for the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul may develop and implement emergency exercise programs for the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul Emergency Plan.
6. **THAT** the Emergency Coordinator, or person appointed by Council may make such amendments as and when required with the approval of Council to the Rural Municipality of West St. Paul Emergency Plan.
