### **Lister Rapids Wastewater Switchover**

Joining Riverdale and Whistler Hollow residents, the neighbourhood of Lister Rapids will be connecting to the new municipal waste water system Wednesday July 19th. Meter readings will be collected July 19th in order to receive initial base measurements. As these meters can be read from the street, meter readers will only need access to homes if the meter is faulty. No disruption of service should be noticed due to the switchover. Thank you for the cooperation and time of all involved, including residents, which have made this milestone possible.

The next community to connect will be River Springs / Rivercrest scheduled for this fall.

#### No motorized vehicles permitted on West St. Paul trails

To help ensure the safety and enjoyment of all users of West St. Paul's Recreational Trail network as well as to help keep the trails in good condition, the RM requests users follow these basic guidelines:

- No motorized vehicles permitted.
- Respect the trail & natural surroundings.
- · Be mindful of other users.

- Leave NO garbage.
- Keep dogs on a leash and clean up after them.
- Be patient when there are sections of a trail temporarily flooded or being serviced. Please report areas in need of maintenance.

If you notice Off Road Vehicle's (ORVs) on the trails please note the description of the riders and other information such as license plate, or lack thereof and report to the local RCMP office.

The RCMP will enforce the rules under the Off Road Vehicle Act. Generally these rules involve excessive speed, erratic or dangerous operation, improper helmet use, under age use, lack no registration or property damage.
